JUDGING CATEGORIES

Please mark "A" or "B" and then choose your category

[] A person: Constructed entirely by 1 person
[] B person: More than one person involved in the construction of the quilt or one Making the top and another person quilted it.
[] Applique by machine: A quilt in which the predominant element or design feature is appliques by machine.
[] Applique Quilt by Hand: A quilt in which the predominant element or design feature is appliqued by hand.
[] Mixed Technique: A quilt combining techniques in one quilt, such as paper piecing, applique, traditional piecing, embroidery, etc.
[] Original Design: A quilt using your own design not derived from a pattern or other artwork.
[] Modern Quilt: Includes but is not limited to the use of bold colors and prints, high contrast and graphic area of solid colors.
[] Quilt Kit: Made from a prepacked kit.
$[\]$ Commercial Panels $\&$ Preprinted Blocks: Panels and preprinted blocks used with the layout of the quilt.
[] Art Quilt Presentational: Pictorial in nature and illustrated a recognizable image such as cityscapes, wildlife nature of people.
[] Art Quilt Non-Representational: Abstract in nature with emphasis on one color line and design. Does not contain recognizable images.
[] Embroidery by Hand: A Quilt in which the predominant element or design feature is embroidered by hand.
[] Embroidery by machine: A quilt in which the predominant element or design feature is embroidered by machine.
[] Other Quilt items: Miscellaneous quilted items such as table runners, bags, clothing items, .
[] Junior Division: (under age 15 years) all categories.
[] Wall Hanging: (size) 48x48 or less.
[] Miniature: (size) 24x24 or less

Quilt Show Rules

- 1. Each Exhibitor may enter a maximum of 2 quilts.
- 2. Each entry must have a separate completed entry form, 1 color photo (no smaller than a 4x6) and check made out to the 'Oregon Quilt Festival".
- 3. All quilts must consist of 3 layers (top, batting and backing) and be quilted by hand or machine. Quilting must be visible from the back. Tied quilts are only allowed in the Junior Division.
- 4. All quilts have a maximum width of 96".
- 5. Each quilt must have a cloth label sewn to the bottom of the backside of quilt. Please include at least your name and phone number.
- 6. No entries previously entered at the OQF.
- 7. The Quilt show committee reserves the right to refuse any quilt that is soiled, damaged, has pet hair on it or smells of smoke, perfume, pet or other odors. The committee also may adjust the category as needed.
- 8. Entry fee is \$10 per quilt plus \$5 for judging fee per quilt.
- 9. By entering your item, you are giving OQF and quilt show visitors permission to photograph your quilt.
- 10. A confirmation letter will be delivered by e-mail after receipt of your completed entry form. Anyone without an email address can request a telephone confirmation.
